

Recycling Process Overview

- ⇒ Recycling is collected in recycle bins in private/office areas and taken to the “Green Spot” collection sites on each floor.
- ⇒ Recycling receptacles are emptied daily by housekeeping.
- ⇒ Recycle contents are taken to the recycling compactors/dumpsters by housekeeping for pickup.
- ⇒ Waste Management vendor hauls recycle materials to recycling processors Batliner, Deffenbaugh, Ripple Glass, etc. for processing.
- ⇒ Rebates from recycling vendors are returned to the Facilities team.

What can I recycle at a Green Spot?

Mixed Recycle Bin

- ⇒ #1- #7 Plastics
- ⇒ Deli or Salad Bar
"Claimshells" (Plastic Only)
- ⇒ Water bottles (including caps)
- ⇒ Aluminum Cans/Drink Cartons
- ⇒ Steel (tin) cans

Waste to Energy/Landfill Bin

- ⇒ Food Waste, wrappers
- ⇒ Plastic bags, tissue paper
- ⇒ Shredded paper
- ⇒ Paper plates, cups & towels
- ⇒ Pizza Boxes, Foil
- ⇒ Plastic Ware, Straws

Paper Bin

- ⇒ Newspapers, Magazines
- ⇒ Envelopes, Manila File Folders
- ⇒ Drink Cartons
- ⇒ Office Paper, Shredded Paper
- ⇒ Junk Mail, Telephone books
- ⇒ Hardback & Paperback books
- ⇒ Construction Paper

Glass Bin

- ⇒ Glass Bottles/Containers (all colors)

Cardboard

- ⇒ Poster board
- ⇒ Cardboard Boxes
- ⇒ Cereal/Snack Boxes
