BRIDGE CLINIC



The K-CART Bridge Clinic is a first step in treatment following the diagnosis of your child. We provide *short-term* behavioral intervention services for your child with an autism spectrum disorder until your family has the opportunity to connect with a service provider in your area. This clinic is for children up to 6 years of age. Services take place at the University of Kansas Medical Center Campus.

Intervention services may include:

- **Skills assessment**
- **Individualized programming based on results from the skills assessment**
- **Assessment of problem behaviors**
- **Function-based treatment plans for problem behaviors**
- **Treatment implemented by providers skilled in autism intervention**
