Data migration of user accounts and attendance history is ongoing. User accounts will not be available on October 1st as originally anticipated. Users will be contacted with login instructions when user accounts are available in eeds. Registration for programs in eeds will be available beginning October 1st. Original Migration Announcement:

Following an extensive review of leading continuing education management systems, we are very pleased to announce that the KU Medical Center Office of Continuing Education will be using eeds (electronic educational documentation system) as our program management system. eeds will replace CloudCME as the KUMC Office of Continuing Education's program management software system. We are moving to eeds in an effort to simplify our continuing education processes and broaden our capacity to support the education needs of our KUMC community.

eeds has undergone many enhancements since we used it previously for the management of regularly scheduled series. Among other uses, eeds will be used for registration, program sign-in, evaluation, and certificate needs going forward as well as the development of enduring material. We plan to begin using eeds for all activities beginning Monday, October 1, 2018. Please see the timeline below for further details on this transition.

CloudCME will no longer be accessible/operational after 11:59 pm on Sunday, September 23, 2018. Although user data and credit history is expected to transfer, as a precaution, we strongly encourage attendees to complete any outstanding evaluations and download their certificates, transcripts, and any other uploads currently in their CloudCME accounts before 11:59 pm on September 23, 2018.

To access CloudCME user data, login to CloudCME at <https://kumc.cloud-cme.com/Ap2.aspx>. The preferred internet browsers to access CloudCME are Mozilla Firefox and Google Chrome. Internet Explorer is not recommended. If you are a CloudCME user, you have been sent an email containing this information. The email at which you received this information is your username. If you do not know your username or are unsure if you have an account, please contact the Office of CE at contactce@kumc.edu or (913) 588-4488. If you do not know your password, you may use the password reset link in the login screen to reset it. You will receive an email within 15-30 minutes with a link to reset your password. Please only click the reset password button once during this time. If you have been locked out of your account due to repeated failed password attempts, please contact the Office of CE and provide the email address for the account that you need to be unlocked.

After you have logged in, sections to download your data from include the Evaluations & Certificates link on the left side for any incomplete evaluations or certificates available for download, the Syllabus link for past program materials (only applicable to select programs), and the Transcript link which shows your credit history along with any documents that you may have uploaded. We encourage you to complete any outstanding evaluations and download all certificates, transcripts, and program materials as applicable. **The deadline to download this information is 11:59 pm on Sunday, September 23, 2018.**
