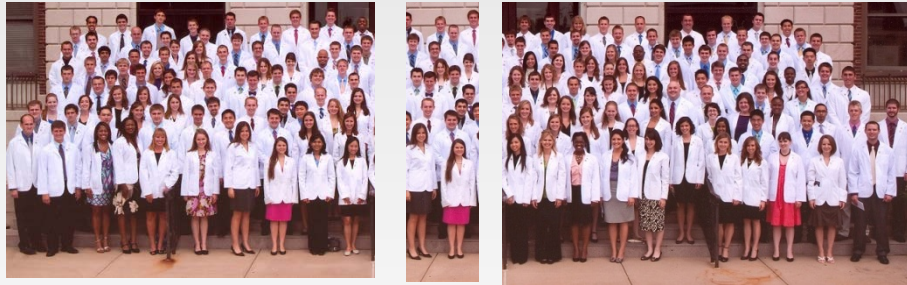

# Growth in: Medical student enrollment

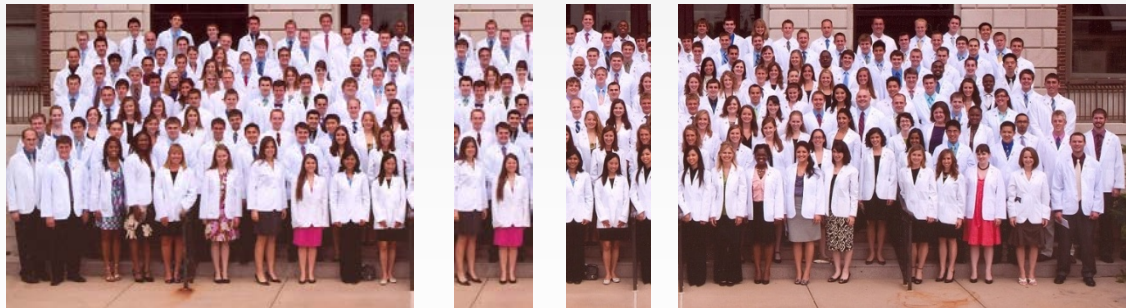

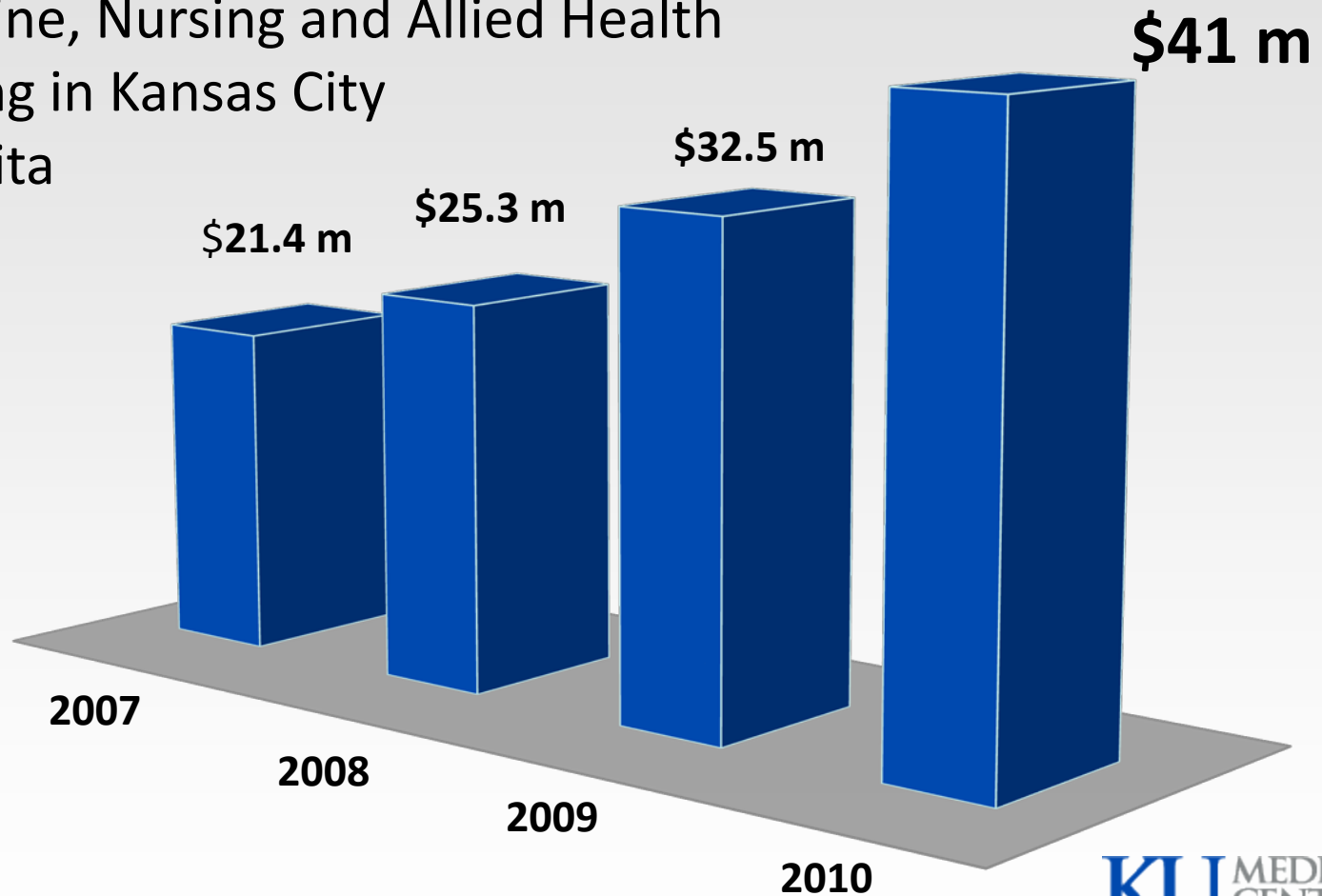


# Growth in: Professional fee revenue

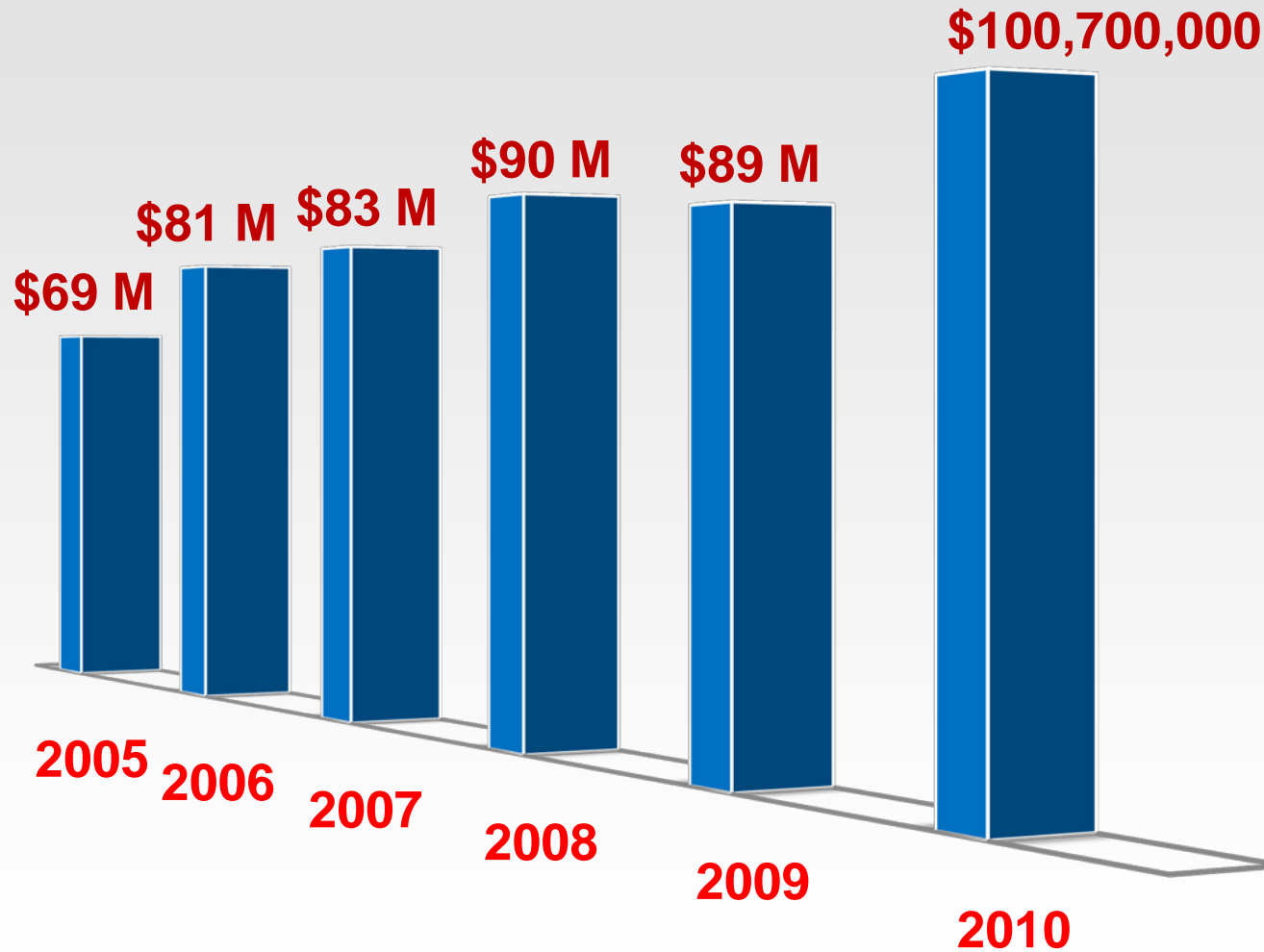


# Growth in: Endowment

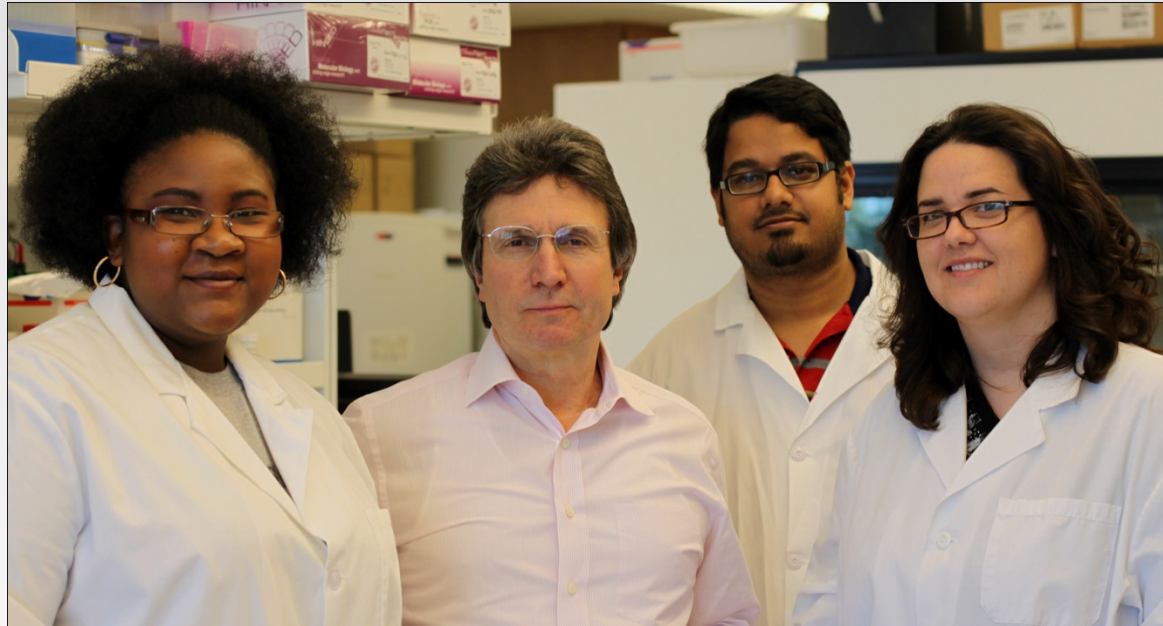

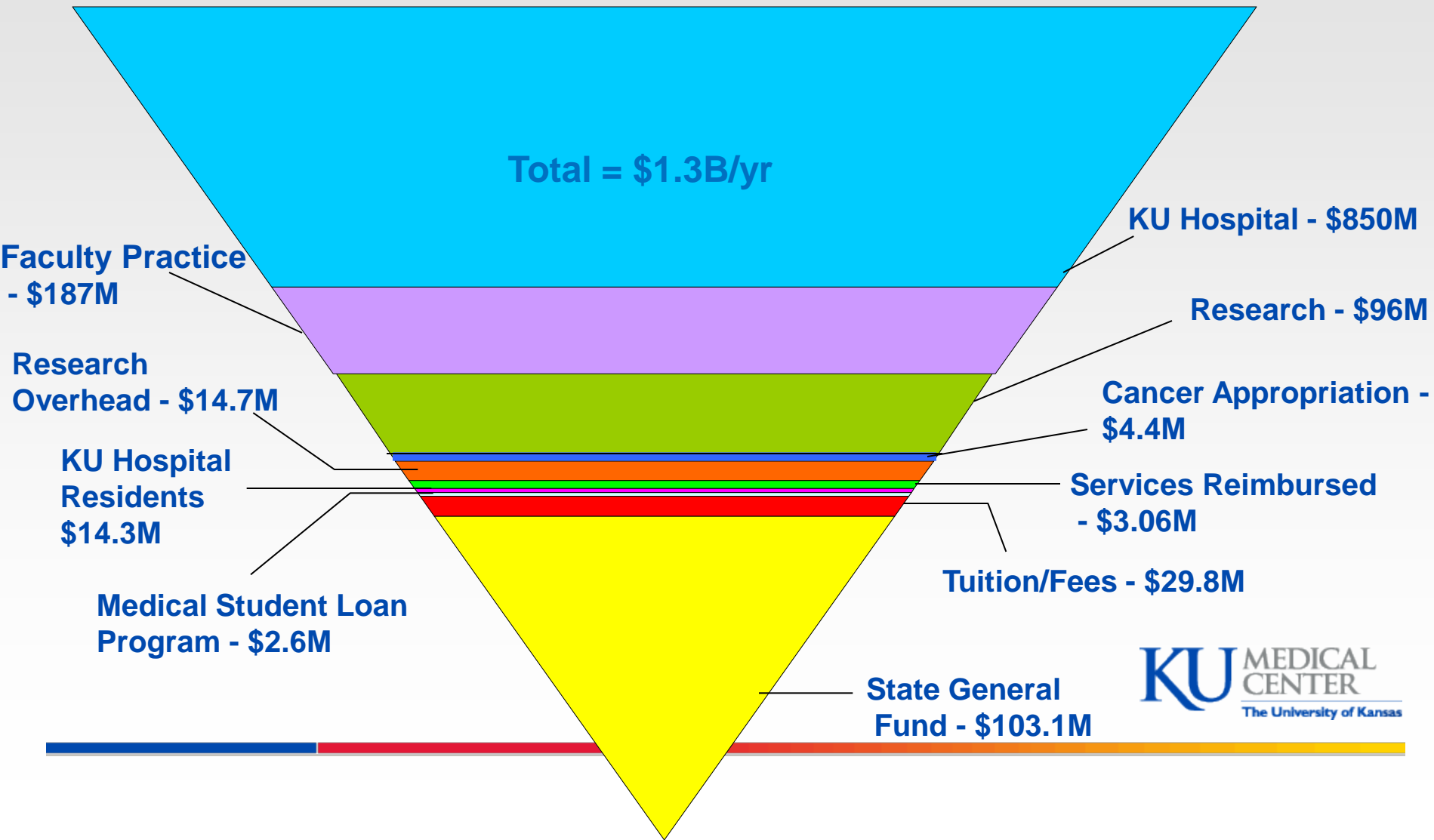

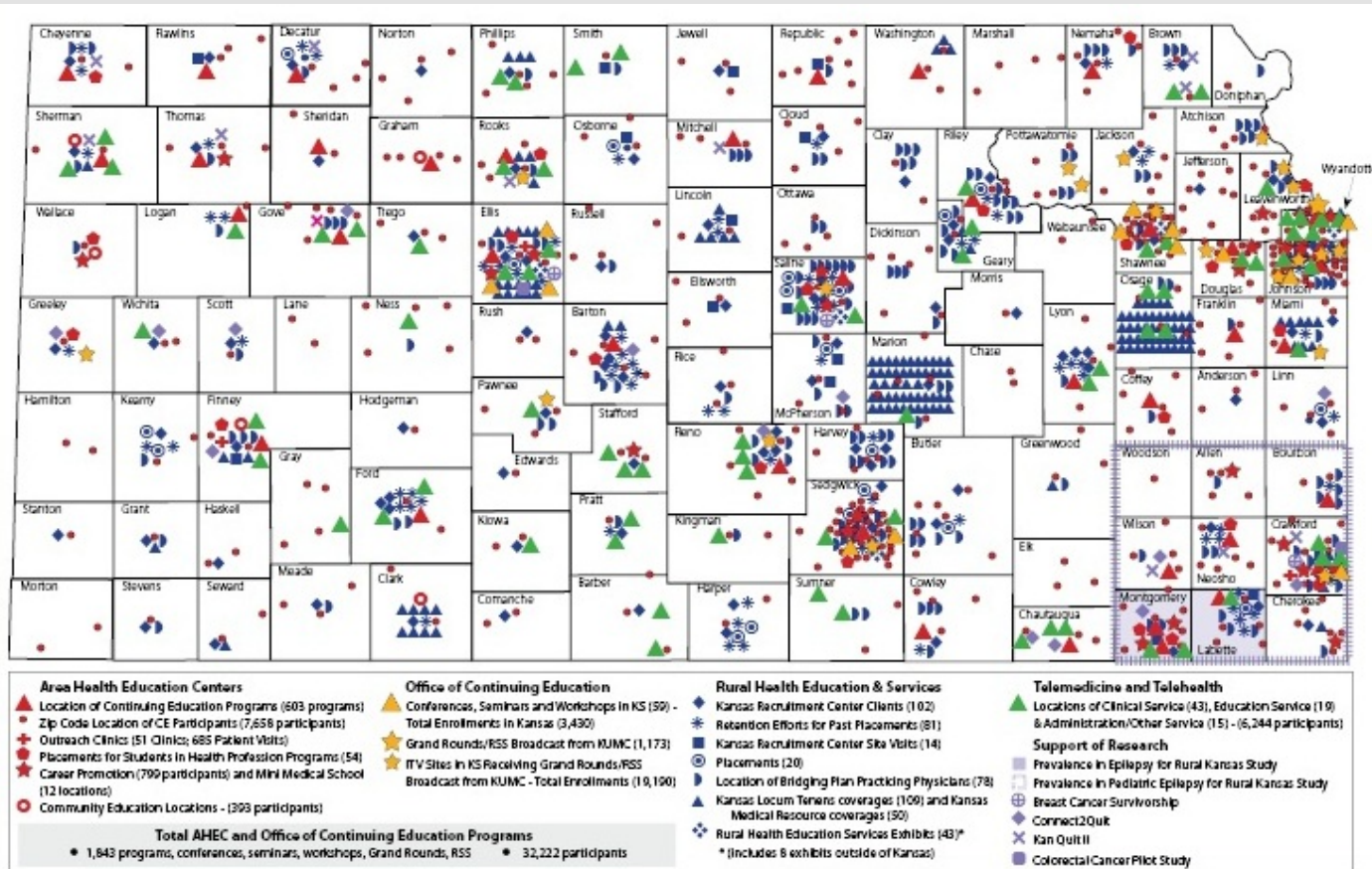

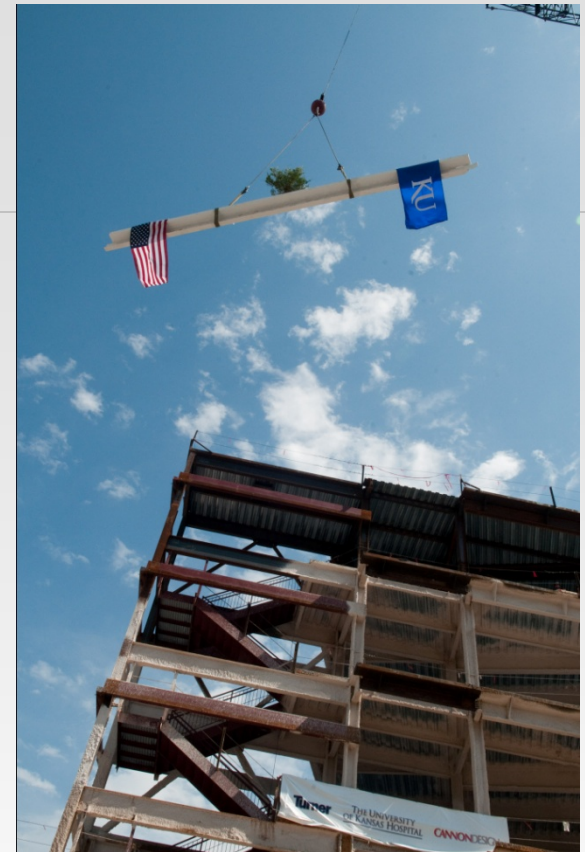
# Aspirations
