1. Rent a vehicle. Minibus taxis are an option, but are not the safest or best way to get there.
2. Instead of cash, have a debit card to use ATMs instead.
3. Scrubs aren't necessary, most wore shorts and polos (guys) or skirts/casual pants (ladies).
4. If flying South African Airways, be prepared for very illogical carry-on requirements.

7. Make sure your phone is unlocked by carrier if wanting to use it with a SA sim card.
8. Internet dongles (Vodacom) are pretty reliable, but may give issues installing on your laptop
9. Adoption Airfare is nice, but was not up front over possible ticket refund hurdles until asked.
10. Be social. The SA doctors and staff are incredibly welcoming and will make the trip great!
