The primary functions of the committee are: 1) review proposals for substantive curricular changes, including changes in the delivery of course content, e.g., when a course offered locally is modified to be delivered to remote sites; 2) review policies regarding student appeals related to academic issues and provide Chair for any Student Grievance Committee formed in the SAH.

No substantive curricular or delivery changes for courses were submitted to the committee this year. Minor changes to existing courses, e.g., course number, credit hours, etc., are submitted directly to the SAH Dean's Office by the department without review by the committee.

One Student Grievance Committee was formed in the school during this academic year. The Dean of SAH appointed Judy Widen as Chair of the committee. The other members of the committee were selected by the Dean, Department Chair, and student. A report was submitted to the Dean's Office following the conclusion of the proceedings.

The committee meets on an "as needed" basis. No formal meetings were held during this academic year.
