

**SAH Appointment, Promotion, & Tenure Committee  
Summary Report for Academic Year 2006-2007**

There was one request this year for a review for promotion to Associate Professor with tenure. The application and supporting documents from the Department and Chair were reviewed in November. The Committee recommended Dean Miller promote the candidate to Associate Professor with Tenure.

This Committee also convened an *ad hoc* committee of full professors from KUMC, and an external committee of the applicant's professional peers to review the application for promotion to Full Professor. Based on these reviews, the APT Committee recommended to Dean Miller that this applicant be promoted to Full Professor.

There also were three faculty members in their third year of the tenure-track process during 2007-2008. As required by the SAH ByLaws, the APT Committee verified that the mandatory three-year reviews were conducted at the Departmental level for each of the mid-tenure process faculty members.

The final task of this Committee was to review and update the Committee's procedures and any other documents related to the Appointment, Promotion, and Tenure process in the School of Allied Health. The official calendar of activities for the APT committee was discussed at the final meeting of the Committee. The first meeting of the APT Committee for academic year 2007-2008 has not been scheduled, but will take place sometime in late August.

A request for an updated list of committee members will be sent to department Chairs early in June. The Chairs also will be asked for the names of any faculty applying for promotion and/or tenure next year, and for the names of any tenure-track faculty who will be in their third year of the tenure process in 2007-2008.
