| VI. Dean's Report        | K. Miller        | <p>The new revenue projections for the state are worse than anticipated. We have already achieved our seven percent reduction for FY10. The federal stimulus money has come through. In terms of higher education, the money will go toward capital improvements and deferred maintenance, and programmatic operations. There are no final numbers on the budget for FY10 yet as the Legislature continues their discussions. We are in a holding pattern as of now, but we don't expect any significant changes and FY11 does not appear to be better. No programs have been cut at the med center, but we may be faced with a tuition increase. Since our student numbers are comparatively small, this does not have a huge benefit for KUMC. The layoffs that have been achieved so far will take effect July 1, but this may continue once the final budget is approved.</p> <p>The Chancellor Search Committee is underway and there are many sought after applicants. They are talking to references now and will likely interview candidates in May. The candidates are highly qualified and the committee is to provide 3-5 names to the Board of Regents upon completion of the interview process. Fortunately, KU is viewed as a desirable University to be a part of.</p> <p>A recent visit from the U.S. Department of Agriculture addressing animal research on our campus did not go well. KUMC is now responding to the U.S.D.A. and an oversight committee has been established.</p> |  |
