

**SAH Student Senate Meeting  
Minutes – September 22, 2003

The meeting began by each attending member introducing themselves as lunch began. The following are topics presented and discussed:

**Budget Report**

Moffett reported to the members the amount of monies available in the SAH Student Senate funds. The following is a breakdown of available funds:

- \$1,400.00 – Restricted Fee Account
- \$541.00 – Safe Keeping Account
- \$1,000.00 – Other Available Funds

**Election of Secretary/Treasurer**

Moffett asked the attending members if anyone was interested as serving as the secretary/treasurer. Rose expressed interest. Clint motioned to officially nominate Rose and all members voted in approval.

**Fall Gathering**

The attending members expressed interest in holding a fall gathering. Moffett explained to all who were not familiar with last years event that it was held at Kelly's / Joe's Pizza in Westport. All the members agreed this years gathering should take place at Kelly's / Joe's Pizza. While no specified date was set, the Senate agreed to look at early November to accommodate traveling students who would miss the event if it were held in December.

**Shirt Sale**

The Senate discussed last year's shirt sale and the significance of holding one once again. The general consensus was positive and this issue will be revisited at a later meeting.

**Election of Chair and Co-Chair**

Moffett expressed the need for a chair and co-chair to be elected at this meeting. Kelli presented her speech to seek the chair position. Kelli provided the group with her background in community service and Student Senate involvement. Jenn informed the Senate she wished to be considered for co-chair. Jenn gave a short speech outlining her motivation and involvement with Girl Scouts. Clint moved to nominate Kelli and Jenn for the respective positions and the Senate voted Kelli as chair and Jenn as co-chair.

**Other Topics Discussed**

- Several students requested some background information on funds allotted for student travel and other resources available to accommodate travel expense.
- Kelli asked the attending members if Mondays would remain a good day to hold Student Senate meetings; the group agreed Mondays will effectively accommodate varying schedules.

- Jenn proposed the idea of an interim SAH Student Senate during the summer months because our programs are not traditionally represented on campus during those months.
- The Senate agreed to hold the October meeting on Monday, October 20, from noon until 1pm and the following meeting will be November 17, from noon to 1pm as well.

The meeting adjourned a few minutes before 1:00 pm.
