

**Student Senate Meeting**  
**Nov. 24, 2003, noon—1pm**

**Health Survey:**

- Kelli had intended to bring a survey for the Senate members to fill out; she did not have it with her for the meeting so she may be stopping us in the hall to hand them out for our input

**Bylaws Change:**

- Issues have arose surrounding our access to funds available during months that the Student Senate has not traditionally met
- We will be focusing on the new idea of implementing the Interim Summer Senate
- Bylaws need to be reviewed

**SGC Alternates:**

- Kelli explained that the School of Allied Health needs representation on the SGC
- Putting alternates in place ensures SAH attendance at SGC meetings
- Katie will serve as the undergraduate alternate and Trina will serve as the graduate alternate (both volunteered for these positions)

**Adopt a Family:**

- After discussion by Moffett about past years' experience w/ adopting a family, Kelli expressed definite interest to sponsor this year also
- Annie, Tiffany, & Meredith volunteered to be on the committee for overseeing this project; Kelli informed the committee that she would be happy to assist
- The Senate expects to spend \$300

**Requests for Funding:**

- Two students applied for funding regarding trips to South Africa
- The Senate, collectively, expressed concerns regarding the process for selection of travel stipends
- It was proposed and unanimously agreed to that in extension to the 2 scholarships the Senate provides, \$500 will be made available in the form of scholarships for various educational endeavors (this will promote equality for programs that do not travel)
- A committee comprised of Kelli, Rose, & Annie will be re-evaluating the application scholarship process for monies from the Student Senate

**T-Shirts:**

- Moffett informed the Senate that out of pocket we will be paying \$14/tee shirt
- It was decided that the students ordering tee shirts will pay \$18/tee shirt
- Money and order forms for tee shirts are due to Moffett on December 8, 2003

**Other Business:**

- Moffett told the members at the meeting that the Kelly's party was a success this year with almost 100 people attending
- Flu shots will probably not be free after this year; Kelli explained that if the shots are free, the students will still be paying for them elsewhere in incurred student fees
