

## Minutes from the SAH Student Senate Meeting – November 29, 2004

- The first item of business for the meeting was brought up by Deuce. Three proposals were made at the last SHOT meeting to improve student health services. The first proposal would be of no cost to students, but the other two would increase student health fees by 20% or 30% to bring in new nursing staff. Another suggestion at the SHOT meeting was to increase student health fees by 100% to bring in another physician. All SAH student senate members agreed to discuss the issue with their classmates and compile a list of students and the particular proposal he or she would prefer to see implemented. This information is to be returned to Deuce ([nmemg@kumc.edu](mailto:nmemg@kumc.edu)) no later than Dec. 6. Ann also suggested that SHOT consider allowing KUMC students to use Watkins Health Center services in Lawrence as another option.
- Shirt sales will probably take place after the Christmas break as the design is still pending.
- Next on the agenda was the Fall Gathering, which will take place on Thursday, Dec. 2 at Kelly's in Westport from 5-8pm. Moffett mentioned that there are legal issues surrounding her presence at the event as a sponsor due to the fact that students will most likely be drinking alcohol. It was decided that members of the senate will collect money, take names, and hand out stickers. The evening was divided into three shifts with Shannon working the door from 5-6, Deuce from 6-7, and Trina from 7-8. The price will be \$3 as usual.
- The senate agreed to do Adopt-A-Family again this Christmas. It was decided that SAH senate would shop for 6 children at \$50 each for a total of \$300. The gifts will be returned to the Alumni office by Dec. 10. Ann, Meredith, and Trina will each shop for two children.
- Funding requests will be discussed after the Christmas break.
- The senate decided to offer two scholarships for the spring. Each will be \$250, and one will go to a graduate student and one to an undergraduate student. This issue will be further discussed next semester.
- Finally, it was mentioned that a possible date for the next senate meeting is Monday, January 24. This date is not confirmed yet, however, and Moffett will send out an email the first week of school next semester to confirm a meeting date.
- The meeting was then adjourned.
