Ear infections in children is focus of Nov. 10 Live & Learn lecture

WICHITA - Ear infections are the most common illnesses in babies and young children. Tugging at ears, ear drainage, balance difficulties, and trouble sleeping are just some of the signs that a child has an ear infection. What are the treatments? Can such infections be avoided?
