



GSC meeting 2-24-04 minutes

1. Jim Bingham – technology update

- a. Gave out packets about the IR portion of last year's student survey
- b. Comments from survey

- i. Need for sequestered study space (individual, small group) typically with computer
 1. result is net increase in 4 small group rooms in integrated library/ITC
 2. working with student tech committee to modify integrated plan to allow redesign or modular design

- ii. Dykes library hours

1. original hours restored November 2003

- iii. Electronic journal access from off-campus

1. created a student FAQ now up on web addressing this and other issues

- iv. Library chairs and tables uncomfortable

1. will need funding that currently isn't available; student tech/library committee looking at alternate styles

- v. Poor maintenance of 2nd floor OM computers

1. doing 2 sweeps per day to ID hardware/software issues
2. no reservation policy for all public computers

- vi. Too many broadcasts
 - 1. numbers have been reduced by restricting access
 - 2. have reinstated student group lists to allow lateral communication (i.e. SOM class 06, Graduate students in medicine, etc.)
 - 3. Campus calendar is now being used more – check through mykumc portal (<https://my.kumc.edu>)
- vii. More online journals
 - 1. currently have ~2000 and are continuing to build
- viii. more study space – will reassess after integration
- ix. Network connectivity, especially wireless
 - 1. assuming no budget problems, O-M Student Center, Dykes, Taylor, SON, WHE and WHW auditoria will be set up for wireless starting in about 8 months
- x. Printing
 - 1. will be testing out a new printing/copy set up based on an account system
- xi. More computers wherever – will reassess after integration

c. Broadcasts

- i. Would like the mykumc portal to evolve like email, where it is checked once or twice a day
- ii. Can have student groups as a channel, providing a ready mechanism for announcements – contact Jameson Watkins to help setup
 - 1. Will develop FAQ about format for announcements

d. Spam Blocker

- i. Still fine tuning the blocker – once finely tuned will shut down spam notification; expected date mid-March

1. Ed Phillips – parking and security

a. Background

- i. Did masterplan in 2000
- ii. Over 1/3 of current space use are uses that the buildings originally weren't designed for
- iii. Have some hard boundaries as far as expansion – State Line Rd., Rainbow Blvd.; path for expansion heading north down Rainbow
- iv. KU Hospital will be staying in its current building
- v. Must have facilities to compete for clinical care and will be constructing new

ambulatory care facility along Olathe

- vi. Research – want to concentrate on the north central part of campus
 - 1. new research building under construction
 - 2. Smith East and West will be taken down and replaced with ambulatory care once the new building is open
 - 3. Contract will be awarded 4-13-04 and building completion expected by 24 months

b. Parking

- i. There was a shortfall of parking spaces prior to construction took out 408 spaces
- ii. Parking **must** pay for parking – has to be self-sufficient
 - 1. \$22 million parking plan in place by Jan 2007
 - iii. KU Endowment Association has bought the Wyandot Mental Health property and once emptied will be demolished and a new 260-space lot will be constructed; expected time Summer '04
 - iv. Elevator in Cambridge parking facility is slow and not ADA compliant; will be replaced within one year
 - v. New structural parking – must build up rather than out
 - 1. 900 faculty/staff/student parking garage will begin construction hopefully late this year
 - 2. 580 spot patient parking to be associated with new ambulatory care

c. Shuttle service

- i. Shuttles run 6:30am – 11:00pm, primarily focused on the north side of campus – make round trips ~every 30 minutes
- ii. Multiple shuttles – 3 for the am rush and 2 for the evening rush
- iii. Point to point – when full go to hospital entrance
- iv. After 6pm departures are only from the front of the hospital
