1. Call to order
2. Kevin McIntire made several announcements regarding:

 - d. Christmas in Oct. email Ramsey McIntire if interested,

 - f. first Ronald McDonald House dinner in the fall.
3. Call for nominations for SGC senators
 - a. Ann Stowe offered to represent the School of Medicine
 - b. School of Nursing: 2 TBD
 - c. Allied Health: 1 TBD
 - d. At Large: 2 TBD
4. Budget Approval
 - a. Ramsey McIntire moved to suspend the Article VI, Section 4 of the GSC Bylaws requiring presentation of the budget at the first meeting of the year so that the budget could be presented and discussed concurrently at this meeting. The motion was seconded by Rohan Gandhi and was passed unanimously.
 - i. It was generally agreed upon that the GSC Travel Grant was insufficient and that the

allocation for GSC food for meetings was too large.

1. Proposed that \$50 from the Fall Activities allocation be redistributed to the GSC Travel Grant.
2. Proposed that the Spring Picnic allocation be increased \$200, with funds coming from the GSC Food allocation.
3. Proposed that the GSC Food allocation be further reduced by \$300, with those funds going to Contingency/Misc.

b. Alan Zidek moved that the budget be approved as proposed above, Christina Newport seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

b. It was explained that student fees cannot be awarded to individual students for the purpose of travel costs and therefore Diversity Health Council could not receive GSC Student Group funds.

c. Erica Perryn motioned that \$600 from the Student Group allocation be divided evenly among the remaining eligible groups (6 at \$100 each), Deb Meyer seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

d. Rohan Gandhi reminded GSC that large events GSC funds need to be advertised so that students know about these events.
