

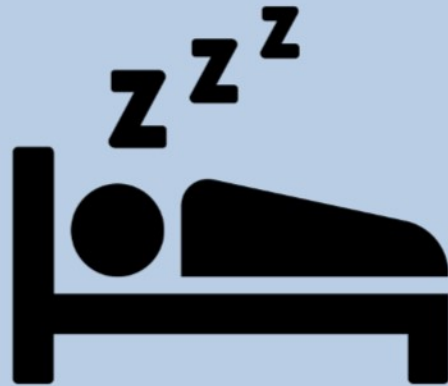
Upper Airway Stimulation Implant Surgery

Upper Airway Stimulation (UAS) implant surgery is an excellent outpatient option for people with moderate or severe obstructive sleep apnea who cannot tolerate CPAP.



96% of our UAS patients sleep better with less snoring and fatigue



70% of our UAS patients no longer suffer from obstructive sleep apnea



Sleep apnea breathing events reduced from 39/hour to 6/hour
