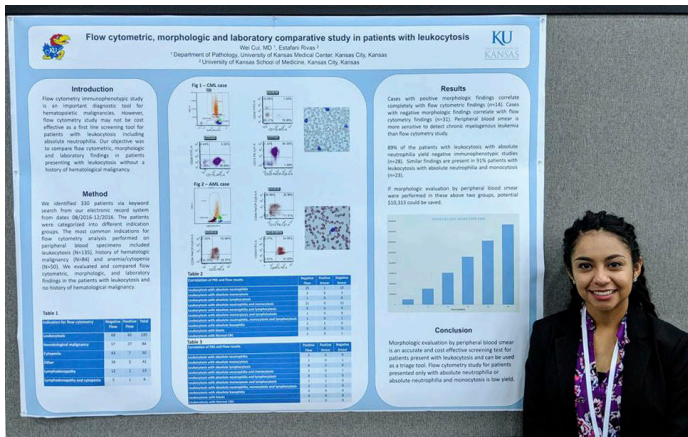


# POST-SOPHOMORE FELLOWSHIP

## KUMC Department of Pathology & Laboratory Medicine

Students work closely with attending faculty and resident pathologists in gross and microscopic diagnoses, intraoperative consultations (frozen sections) and clinical pathology consultations. Students will also prepare case material for presentation at departmental and subspecialty conferences and have the opportunity to participate in research projects. This 12 month fellowship typically commences on June 1 and runs through May of the subsequent year.

PSFs are provided an annual stipend and parking permit.

### Currently accepting applications for the 2021-2022 program.

To apply for the Post-Sophomore Fellowship Program: Obtain a hard copy or electronic application from the pathology education coordinator (contact information below) and refer to our departmental site, <http://www.kumc.edu/school-of-medicine/pathology.html> for further information. Applications must include original signature, are reviewed in order of receipt and available positions are offered commencing November 2020 through the end of January 2021.

#### Please include with your application:

- Two (2) letters of support\*
- Sealed medical school transcript
- Standard passport-sized photograph
- Current *curriculum vitae*
- Personal statement of interest
- Letters should be addressed to Dr. Madan and emailed or mailed to the office manager.

Students desiring a very special opportunity to gain clinical and research experience in pathology should consider applying for the Post-Sophomore Fellowship (PSF) open each academic year in the department. One to two students from LCME-accredited undergraduate medical schools may be selected and will have rotations and duties similar to first-year residents in pathology. This will provide the student a unique avenue to expand his or her current knowledge base through hands-on experience in a hospital setting. One-half year of basic science laboratory research with departmental faculty may be available for qualifying students.

#### Examples of PSF rotation assignments might include:

- Surgical Pathology (2-4 months)
- Cytopathology
- Hematopathology
- Neuropathology
- Dermatopathology
- Clinical microbiology
- Autopsy pathology
- Blood banking
- Choice of electives
