LEGACY SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Applications to be selected as the KUMC ASAHP LEGACY SCHOLARSHIP nominee are due in the SHP Dean's office by 4pm on November 23rd.

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| Midwest Association of Allied Health Deans of Academic Health Centers |
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This scholarship program was established to honor the legacies of current and former deans and directors of the Midwest Association of Allied Health Deans of Academic Health Centers. The scholarship is awarded to students with at least one term or semester remaining in their professional area of study who possess professional and interpersonal qualities that indicate that they are likely to establish their own legacies of excellence in service, teaching, and/or research in the allied health professions.

Up to three scholarships of \$2500 will be awarded nationally; both undergraduate and graduate students are eligible. Submissions will be restricted to member institutions of the Midwest Association of Allied Health Deans of Academic Health Centers and **limited to one per institution**. The selected student's application must be submitted on his/her behalf by Dean Akinwunan's office on December 01, 2018.

Selection criteria

- Involvement in service and interprofessional activities
- Demonstrated leadership

Required documents each applicant must submit:

1. Application Form
2. Letter of recommendation from the chair or director of the applicant's professional program
3. Letter of support from the Dean
4. A short résumé (not more than two pages) that includes a summary of his or her education, research, service, and interprofessional activities
5. A one page essay (8.5 x 11 inches, Times New Roman 12 pt. font, single-spaced, one inch or greater margins), that addresses the following topic:

Describe an individual who has been a role model in your life and how this person has inspired you to create your personal legacy of success in your chosen profession.

Submitting the application

- The application, essay and the résumé must be given by the applicant to the dean of the applicant's school by a deadline set each year by the respective dean. The letter of recommendation from the chair or director of the applicant's professional program shall also be provided to the dean by the same deadline.
- If the dean agrees to support the application, she/he shall also provide a letter of support. Applications lacking a letter of support by the applicant's dean will not be considered.
- The dean shall then mail the two letters, the application, the essay, and the résumé (as listed above) in the same envelope to:
