Interprofessional Teaching Clinics

During the semester that the dietetic intern completes the Clinical Nutrition rotation, she/he will be required to complete two half day sessions each within the Teams Based Teaching Clinic (TBTC) and Geriatric Interprofessional Assessment Clinic (GIAC). Interns will be assigned two consecutive weeks (GIAC Wednesday afternoons, TBTC Tuesday mornings) or based on preference from preceptor. It is the responsibility of the intern to inform the preceptor of what days they have been assigned to the TBTC/GIAC clinics.
