The Early Career Achievement Alumni Awards will be presented to alumni from the KU Schools of Health Professions, Medicine and Nursing who are early in their healthcare careers. The award recognizes an individual's contributions:

- early in his or her career
- in his or her respective profession
- to patient care
- to research and/or publications
- to community service or volunteering

Note: the individual must have received the first degree in their field within the last 20 years.

The Honorary Alumni Awards will be presented to non-graduates of KUMC who have made significant impact through their professional or personal contributions. The award recognizes an individual's contributions:

- in his or her field
- to KU or KUMC
- to health care
