## Why Participate?

## Who Can Participate?

- Adults with Down syndrome who are 25 years or older
- Must be accompanied by a qualified study partner



## ABC-DS Study Details

- Visits every 16 months for a total of four visits, over approximately five years
- The following procedures could be performed depending on the study visit: *blood draws, MRI and PET scans, questionnaires, and a cognitive assessment*
- Compensation is available



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
