In December 2016, most Emergency Medicine faculty received full-time appointments; in July 2018, Mid-America physician faculty were added as full-time faculty to the newly created departments of Cardiovascular Medicine or Cardiovascular & Thoracic Surgery. Therefore these exceptions were eliminated starting with FY 2018 and FY 2019, respectively.
