Therefore, the definition of URM used here includes American Indian/Alaskan Native, Black/African American, Hispanic, Pacific Islander/Native Hawaiian, and those classified as Two or More Races. Due to the lack of additional ethnic data and the large number of faculty who did not report their race or ethnicity, the URM percentage stated here may be an underestimate of the true URM percentage.

⁴ Hispanic is an ethnicity option provided on the employment form. Respondents answer either yes or no. Any employee choosing yes on the hispanic question is counted as a Hispanic.

⁵ The inclusion of some volunteer faculty in the official faculty counts beginning in FY 2010, for which ethnic or race data on these types of faculty is often unknown, partly explains the large increase in this category for reports that span the FY 2010 period. Referring to footnote 1, the number of unknowns should decrease starting with FY 2018 and into FY 2019.
