Each research award and its funding is attributed to the primary department indicated by the principal investigator (PI), which in most cases is the academic home of the PI; therefore, this report is not meant to portray total research activities by KUMC's research centers and institutes. Further, beginning with their FY 2016 Annual Report, the RI has reattributed awards indicated in our source systems that show as lying within a center or institute back to the academic home of the PI, where possible. The "NIH" column includes flow-through amounts. The # of awards listed are those grants, contracts or clinical trials which received funding during the fiscal year.
