

Google Scholar recently changed how their export process works.

Google Scholar Changes:

After selecting the records and choosing export, Google Scholar then sends you to a window that looks like this:

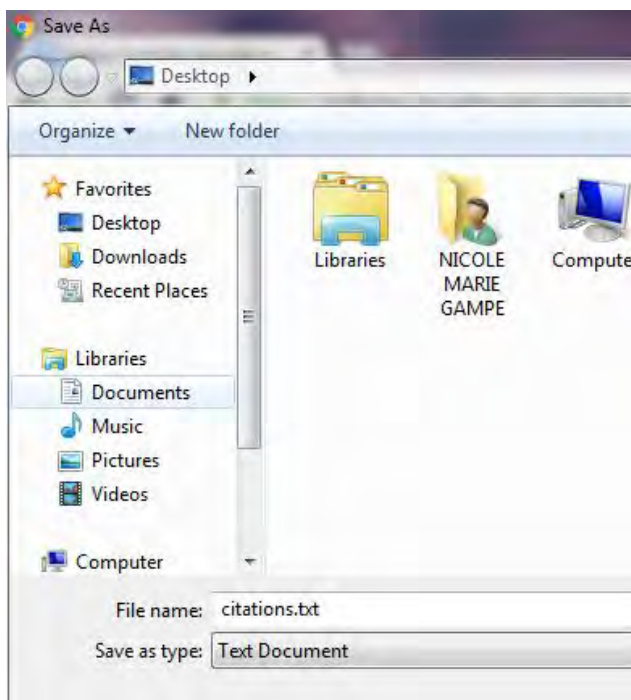

Once this window opens, *right click* anywhere on the screen and you will see:



Left click on Save as... this window will then pop up:



Note where the file is being saved and the name of the file.
