If approval not received, student must enroll in fall semester.</p> <p>July 4: Independence Day Holiday, no classes</p> <p>July 14: Last day for fall graduates to complete a general exam, project, thesis defense or dissertation defense, including electronic filing of thesis or dissertation, if applicable.</p> <p>July 15: Last day to submit Application for Degree (AFD) for master's, doctorate, and/or graduate certificate program.</p> <p>July 28: Last day of classes</p> <p>July 28: Last day for Summer 2022 master's and doctoral students to meet all degree requirements. This includes the electronic filing of thesis/dissertation by master's thesis and PhD candidates (dissertation). No extensions will be granted.</p> <p>August 1: Summer semester award date for degrees and certificates. (Degrees formally conferred May 2024 Commencement)</p> <p>August 11: Final day to obtain Graduate Studies' approval of thesis or dissertation for summer graduation. This is also the final day for departments to complete the Summer Graduation Report.</p>

Completion of Degree Requirements include: (a) grades posted for all required courses (no WG or I grades) with resulting cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher; (b) Application for Degree (AFD) is submitted in Enroll & Pay; (c) electronic filing of thesis/dissertation, if applicable; and (d) required thesis/dissertation paperwork is filed with the Office of Graduate Studies. Students are required to enroll in the semester they graduate, unless they meet the graduation requirements by the early dates above. If student does not meet these requirements by these dates, they must enroll for the full semester in which they will graduate.
