

**REQUEST TO PETITION FOR
 EMPLOYMENT BASED LEGAL PERMANENT RESIDENCY (LPR) OR
 O-1 VISA (INDIVIDUALS WITH EXTRAORDINARY ABILITY OR ACHIEVEMENT)**

In order for the University of Kansas Medical Center to petition for employment based permanent residency or O-1 visa, the sponsoring department or candidate must do the following:



Prior to the start of any work on LPR or O-1 petitions, approval must be obtained from the Vice Chancellor for Academic Affairs, Dr. Robert M. Klein. In order to file for LPR, you are required to work with an attorney approved by KUMC's General Counsel. For more information on university approved attorneys, please contact the Office of International Programs. The following supporting documents must be included with this form for a request to be considered:

- Letter of support on department letterhead from sponsoring department or supervisor including the following information:**
 - Addressed to the Vice Chancellor for Academic and Student Affairs, Dr. Robert M. Klein
 - Justification for petitioning for permanent residency or O-1 visa
 - Details about the position and how the candidate was recruited
 - Any other relevant details
- CV from candidate**
