- Improve understanding and cooperation
- Provide structure and predictability
- Clarify routines
- Help with transitions or changes in routine
- Teach new skills
- Make abstract concepts more concrete (e.g., time)
- Can build in reinforcement/rewards
- Can be pictures, symbols, text/writing, or a combination!
