



2024 Chancellors Club Research Award Request for Nominations

The University of Kansas Medical Center, Vice Chancellor for Research, Matthias Salathe, M.D., is pleased to announce the request for nominations recognizing an outstanding researcher for the Chancellors Club Research Award. The 2023 recipient of this award was John P. Thyfault, PhD, FACSM, FTOS from the KU School of Medicine, Departments of Cell Biology, Physiology, and Internal Medicine.

The Chancellors Club Research Award, which carries with it a \$10,000 prize, is presented to an individual in recognition of exceptional achievements that have had significant and long-term impact on a research field. The research should be of national and/or international merit and should have profoundly affected later development of a field or represent a productive record of significant research. The award may be bestowed only once in a faculty member's lifetime.

All Kansas City, Wichita or Salina faculty (other than prior winners) who have had an appointment at the University of Kansas Medical Center for a least four (4) years are eligible to apply. This includes past winners of the Faculty Research Investigator Award. Selection of the Chancellors Club Research Award will be based on the following non-ranked criteria:

1. Publication of research in peer-reviewed journals;
2. Significant peer-reviewed external grant support;
3. Presentations and invited lectures to major local, regional, national or international scientific conferences, meetings, or academic institutions, or policy-making bodies;
4. Peer recognition in the form of elected offices in professional societies, memberships on journal editorial boards, and/or membership on local, regional, national and international committees (e.g., study sections, consultantships, advisory boards, etc.);
5. Previous recognition as a recipient of honors and awards from local, regional or national organizations and/or other academic institutions; and
6. Training of graduate students and/or fellows who have made significant independent scientific or societal contributions.

The recipient will be honored during a university recognition, to be finalized at a later date.

Submission of Materials: The nominating material should include a) the candidate's complete current *curriculum vitae*; b) a concise 1–2-page statement of the nominee's research accomplishments written by the person(s) nominating the candidate, c) a copy of the candidate's most significant publications (five maximum); and d) two letters from scientific peers outside the University of Kansas system. The statement of the nominee's research accomplishments is of critical importance in evaluating the application's merits. It should be based on material contained within the CV but is intended as a supplement.
