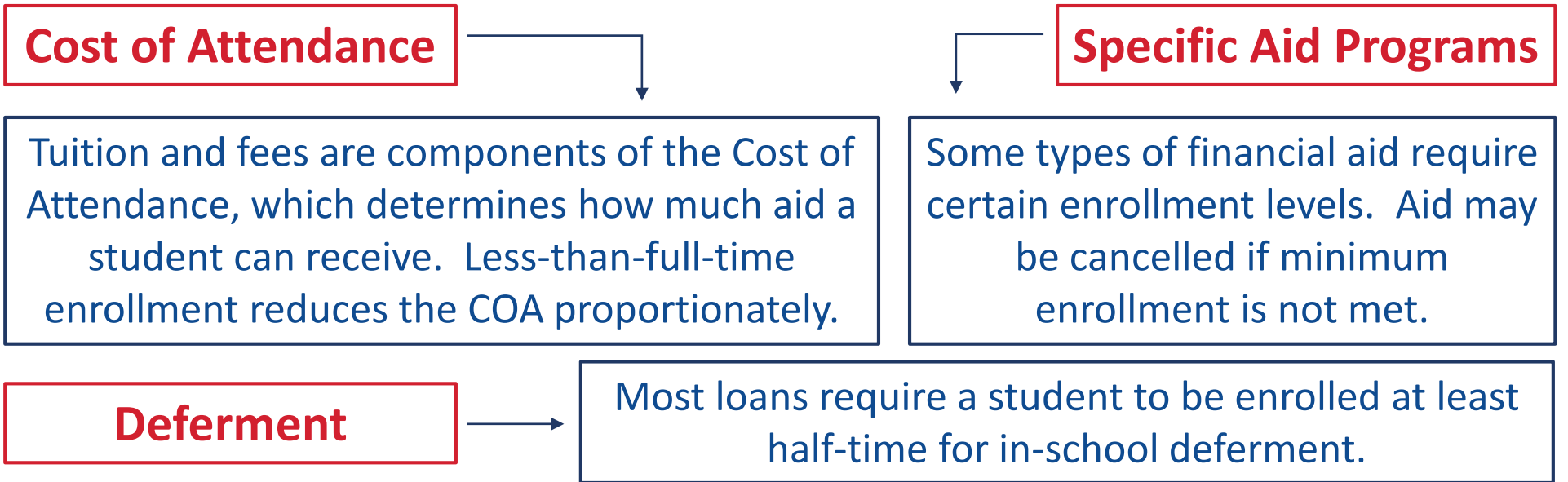


ENROLLMENT LEVELS -

How does enrollment affect my financial aid?

The number of credit hours a student takes can impact the amount or type(s) of aid a student they receive.



MD Students Full-time with at least one credit hour per semester

Graduate Students	<u>Full-Time</u> Fall or Spring: 9 credit hours Summer: 6 credit hours	Exceptions: Students enrolled in dissertation coursework need only enroll in one credit hour to be full-time. Students with a GTA, GRA, or GA appointment should visit the Graduate Studies website for specific enrollment levels.
	<u>Half-Time</u> Fall or Spring: 5-8 credit hours Summer: 3-5 credit hours	
	<u>Less-Than-Half-Time</u> Fall or Spring: 1-4 credit hours Summer: 1-2 credit hours	

Undergraduate Students	<u>Full-Time</u> Fall or Spring: 12 credit hours Summer: 6 credit hours	<u>Three-Quarter-Time</u> Fall or Spring: 9-11 credit hours Summer: 5 credit hours
	<u>Half-Time</u> Fall or Spring: 5-8 credit hours Summer: 3-4 credit hours	<u>Less-Than-Half-Time</u> Fall or Spring: 1-5 credit hours Summer: 1-2 credit hours
