Students pursuing the RN to BSN option complete the associate degree in nursing first, and then complete their BSN through this flexible program.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS: Applicants must complete all the prerequisite courses below and provide proof of a current RN license prior to the start of classes. Other requirements include a minimum cumulative GPA of at least 2.50, completion of all the prerequisite courses detailed below, three letters of reference, a professional resume, and the online application.

When calculating GPA, all non-vocational and non-remedial courses from all colleges and universities attended are considered. Except for Intermediate Algebra, remedial courses are not factored into the GPA. When a course is repeated, both the original and the new grade are factored into the GPA. Except for A.D.N. courses, courses that do not transfer to KU are not factored into the GPA.

KU APPLICATION DEADLINE: All application materials, including transcripts and references, **MUST** be received by **July 1st for the fall, December 1st for the spring, or April 1st for the summer**. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

LIBERAL ARTS REQUIREMENTS: Courses with grades of "D" or "F" will not be counted. No Pass/Fail courses will be accepted.
